

USVI MENTAL HEALTH FUND

In September 2023 JPMorgan Chase (“JPM”) settled a lawsuit by the U.S. Virgin Islands (“GVI”) alleging that JPM facilitated and benefited from the sex trafficking of women by Jeffrey Epstein. The settlement payment made by JPM to GVI was in the amount of \$75 million US dollars (the “Settlement Payment”). The settlement includes that \$10 million US dollars of the Settlement Payment will be used to create a fund (the “Mental Health Fund”) to provide a financial resource for mental health services for survivors of Jeffrey Epstein.

You may qualify to apply to the Mental Health Fund if you fall into one or more of the below categories:

- Participating Claimants of the settlement of *Jane Doe I v. JP Morgan Chase Bank, N.A.* (“JPM Class Action”)¹
- Participating Claimants of the settlement of *Jane Doe I v. Deutsche Bank Aktiengesellschaft, et al.* (“DB Class Action”)
- A Class Member of the JPM Class Action
- A Class Member of the DB Class Action
- A participant in the Epstein Victims Compensation Fund

The Claims Administrator in both the JPM Class Action and the DB Class Action, Simone Lechuk, will be administering the Mental Health Fund. The Claims Administrator will be accepting applications to the Mental Health Fund during the period January 15, 2024 through July 15, 2024 (11:59 PM EDT). You can find the necessary application form at this website: www.USVIMentalHealthFund.com. The Claims Administrator will be making distributions directly to mental health providers on behalf of approved applicants, for approved services for two years. Payments will be made by wire transfer on a monthly basis to the provider in the currency designated by the provider.

The Claims Administrator will review and consider proposed treatment programs on a rolling basis during the enrollment period. The Claims Administrator reserves the right to request additional information prior to her determination. Once an applicant has an approved treatment plan, payment to a mental health provider will be made directly to the provider on a monthly basis. The Claims Administrator recognizes that treatment plans may evolve over time and will consider amendments to any approved treatment.
